We wanted to let you know of some changes that are coming to the LUMC Diaper Bank **on January 1, 2018.**

- 1) The LUMC Diaper Bank will distribute to families that reside in Anderson County. Address will now need **to be verified** through a driver's license, utility bill, signed lease agreement, or some forms of mail sent to you at that address (bank statement, credit card statement, etc).
- 2) Diapers will **only be released to the individuals listed on the registration form (2 adult names at most)**. If you are unable to make it to a regular distribution, please contact us and diapers can be left at Bluegrass Community Action on Hilltop Drive. **We will no longer be able to let someone else pick up your diapers for you.**
- 3) If school is closed for weather related reasons, **our distribution will be canceled** and no make-up will be rescheduled.
- 4) The child you are requesting diapers for **must live with you** at least half of the time.
- 5) We will now require you to provide us the **full name and date of birth of the child** that you are requesting diapers for.

All families currently receiving diapers must complete the revised Diaper Bank Application at your next diaper pickup, which states that you have read and agree with these rules, and you must provide proof of Anderson County residency. You will be unable to pickup diapers more than 1 more time until residency is confirmed.
